ANNUAL ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR 2018 -2019

A) CHILD WELFARE PROGRAMME

The children welfare program has been instrumental in helping the poor and the needy children of the society by helping them get education and other basic needs through this program. During the Financial year 2018 – 2019 Children Have Hope team has been working hard to fulfil the purpose of uplifting the poor and the needy children through social, physical and educational programmes. This year 325 Children have got the privilege to go to good schools and compete with the other children of the society. Many of them have achieved their goal and have come out with flying colours, whereas there are few who have been struggling in their academic performance. This year the CHH team have been instrumental in the children's lives and have been facilitating them in their annual school fees, admission, monthly fees, school uniforms, books and stationery, food, school bags shoes etc. Among the 325 students 27 appeared for their Class 10 examinations while 18 appeared for their Class 12 examinations in March and April. Some of them have successfully completed their examinations with better results while few of them didn't manage to pass the examination. In the course of the year the Children Have Hope team have been able to hold a summer camp in October 2018 for Children of Mission hill. Meenglass, Dudhia Hospital line, Dudhia Bazar, Tarwa busty, Pankhabari, Velacoop, Garidhura Bawan Pokhari, Chunbhatti, Sepoydhura, Rohini, Anarasbari, Toribari, Bethgera, and Pradhan Nagar. Most of the children were from the plain areas surrounding Siliguri. We had almost 122 of them. During this summer camp 102 turned up while some of them were not feeling well. The children were taken to Dream Land, Ranidanga. We were also able to hold a one day

winter camp for the children of Salbari, Rajiv Nagar, Pokaijote, Subolbhitta Panitanki Naxal, New rangia, Dewmoni, Bagdogra, Buttabari, Toribari Jabra, Panighatta, M.M.terai and lohapool. The idea behind the winter camp was to provide children with refreshment, fun, outing, interaction between the children and also medical check-up.

Apart from regular studies, the children are also provided with tuitions so that they can get moral & value education. This way, the CHH team also comes to know about their needs and short-comings which the team helps; counsel them and also meet their parents to discuss about their children.













SOCIAL WORKERS

During the Financial year 2017-2018 B.S.S.S. for Christ had 21 evangelists working in the field areas of **Jalpaiguri**, Mission Hill, Meenglass, Gorubathan, Odlabari, Chalsa, Hasimara and Jaigaon; Kalimpong Pedong Busty; Darjeeling at 6th Mile, Singmari, Dali, Lingya and Rajbari; Kurseong at Ambootia and Tindharia; Mirik at Dhajjia and Phuguri; Sikkim at Reshi and Tinkitam; Siliguri at Nirpani; Nepal at Illam, Jhapa and Danabari. Overall, they have reached to more than 1975 villages and shared the gospel to 22142 people. During this period, 2975 people have come to Christ, claiming him as their saviour. The evangelist have also been instrumental in bring their disciples for one month disciple ship training and three months advance discipleship training. The evangelist have also been instrumental in helping the poor and the needy and doing social work whereby uplifting the society.

TRAINING CENTRE

In the financial year 2018-2019 we have been able to host 272 students in 6 different batches of one month discipleship training and three months advance discipleship training. During the course of the training we have been able to host both theoretical and practical classes. In the theoretical classes they have been taught how to disciple others and to follow the footsteps of the lord while in the practical classes they have been taken to different villages to share the gospel. During this year the students were able to share the gospel to 10325 and 3241 has been able to accept the lord as their personal saviour. The students went to several villages like Panighatta, M.M.Terai Sisha bari and Medical hospital.

HEBZEBAH POLYCLINIC

The Hebzebah Polyclinic, a unit of B.S.S.S for Christ has been playing an important role in providing medical assistance to the poor & needy and to the sick people of the community. During the financial year 2018-2019 Hebzebah has been operating 6 days a week, Doctor, nurse and the pharmacist has been very cooperative and helping us by giving advises as to uplift Hebzebah. In this year the Hebzebah team has been able to provide medical assistance to 3158 people in the Clinic During this year the team has been able to hold 7 free medical health camps (once in a month) Except on October and December in places where there is almost no medical assistance for the people of the community and have to walk to distant places for their medical supplies. This year the team has visited places such Ganga Nagari, Manza Nicheyline, Dawhara jote, Nirpani Raitola, Rakhem Jote, Central Forest busty, Sonachadi, Loha singh etc. Most of the places are poverty stricken Places which are the tea plantation belts. In this year were able to extend our medical assistance to 552 people during our free health medical camp.

This year we had to get bio medical and licence renewed as per the norms and regulation laid out by the Govt of India.
